Check-in	All divisions check in at the dinghy park from 9.45 am.	
Briefing & Starts	All divisional races and lightning races, briefing 10.30 starts from 11.00. All Assessment races briefing at 12.30 starts from 1.00.	
Rules	BCU Marathon Racing Committee rules will apply. All promoted paddlers will gain 1 Hasler Finals point for their club. The race will be run in accordance with the current BCU Marathon Rules. Division 1 - 9 competitors must be Comprehensive	

BCU/Canoe England/WCA/SCA/CANI members, or members of the Junior Section of a BCU Affiliated Club. A current BCU or Junior Section Card must be shown at check-in. **Paddlers ranked in Div 1 - 6 without proof of membership will not be permitted to race. Paddlers ranked in Div 7 - 9 without proof of membership may purchase an event ticket at £2.50, for insurance purposes.** Paddlers in doubles divisions must declare their singles ranking at check-in or will not qualify for Hasler points.

Approved buoyancy aids must be worn by all division 7, 8 and 9 paddlers. All paddlers are advised that river conditions can be adverse at this time of year. Vertical number plates are compulsory for all except division 9 boats.

Prizes

Prize giving will take place as soon as possible after the end of racing. There will be prizes for the winner of each quorate division plus others as appropriate.

£2 per seat lightning & Hody K2
